Wow! I can't believe 2017 is already over. It seems like it just started. What an amazing year it was. World Changers, Disciple Now, Spring Break, as well as, many other activities. As I think of the New Year ahead, I think of starting something new or pushing the re-set button on some areas of my life. As we start this New Year I want to ask you a question: What will you give to Jesus this year? I want to challenge you in 4 different areas.

Area #1 – Give Him Your Trust. Faith is a voluntary matter. Jesus doesn't have your trust unless you give it to Him. He will never force it

Area #2 – Make Jesus first place in your life. If anything or anyone other than Jesus holds first place in your life, it's an idol. This Christmas choose to make Jesus first in your finances, interests, relationships, schedule – even in your troubles.

Area #3 – Give Jesus Your Heart. Your heart is what you love, what you value, and what you care about most. Jesus says, "Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also" (Luke 12:34). One important way you give Jesus your heart is by giving your resources to his work. Jesus doesn't need your money, but he wants what it represents – your heart.

Area #4 – Bring other people to Jesus. God wants a family more than anything else. He wants children who choose to love and trust Him. It is the reason we celebrated Christmas. Invite someone to Jesus. Tell someone about what Jesus has done in your life.
