
Lesson 5: Like Jesus

Icebreaker:

If you have a "follow the leader" type game (games like "Simon," "Bop It" and others that make you repeat a series of actions), play a couple of rounds. If you don't have a game, you can try an actual round of "follow the leader" with some increasingly funny/difficult actions.



Alternative:

Describe a time you tried to do something just like your parents (example: My dad let me "shave" with a toy plastic razor while he was shaving in the morning). Ask if anyone has some similar stories or examples.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. What does WWJD (What Would Jesus Do) mean to you?
- 2. 2 Corinthians 5:17 says, "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!" What does the Bible mean that we are a "new creation" in Christ?
- 3. What encourages you to follow Jesus' example in the way you live?
- 4. What would change in the world if everyone actually lived according to the an honest answer to "what would Jesus do"?
- 5. What do you find most challenging about the Bible's statement "The man who says, 'I know him,' but does not do what he commands is a liar, and the truth is not in him" (1 John 2:5)?
- 6. If we are saved by grace, not by what we do (Ephesians 2:8-9) why does the Bible say so much about what we do (Ephesians 2:10)?
