

3 - How to Respond to Attacks on the Bible

The WORD

Icebreaker:

Make the statement "Vanilla ice cream is the best flavor of ice cream."

Ask how many people in the group agree with that statement. Does anyone disagree? Have a two minute debate on the subject (or if everyone agrees, divide the group in half, and ask one half to choose a different flavor and defend it as the best flavor of ice cream).

After the debate ask:

What arguments were convincing? What arguments were not convincing? What made the difference?
